Getting Ready for Winter

Disconnect your garden hose from all exterior faucets.

Make sure your tires have the proper amount of tread on them, and check your air pressure so you will be safe in the snow.

Keep an emergency kit in your vehicles such as: jumper cables, flash light and batteries, blanket, small tool kit, tow strap, shovel, bottled water and protein bars.

Utilize caution when driving in wintery conditions. Slow your speed, increase following distance.

Allow plow trucks to clear the roads, and do not run errands during a storm.

Do not leave unattended vehicles running to warm up. This allows potential car theft.
